

# Buy a Jackson Hole Icon

Your chance to get the last of the original Town Square Arches

Beyond the towering Teton Range, Jackson Hole, Wyoming is probably most well known for its one-of-a-kind elk antler arches, which anchor each corner of the small town's unique Town Square. The antlers from the arch on the northwest corner of the Town Square will go on the auction block Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015 immediately after the famous BSA Elk Antler Auction.

Three of the four arches were over fifty years old and their condition deteriorating when the Rotary Club of Jackson Hole generously spearheaded an effort, along with the Town of Jackson, to pay for rebuilding each of these amazing landmarks. Selling the antlers from the arches to the highest bidder will provide some of the necessary funding to purchase new antlers for refurbishing the icons. The first arch, on the southwest corner, was auctioned and replaced in 2007. The last arch up for sale will be the arch sitting on the northwest corner of Jackson's Town Square.

"I have no doubt millions of people have had their pictures taken under the arches in downtown Jackson over the years," said Mayor Mark Barron. "We are thrilled the Rotary Club has taken on this project to preserve and maintain part of our western history."

Each spring, the local chapter of the Boy Scouts of America pick up the naturally shed antlers from the thousands of elk who winter in Jackson Hole on the National Elk Refuge. Saturday, May 16<sup>th</sup> the antler will be sold at the annual BSA Elk Antler Auction. The auction of the antler in the arch will immediately follow the BSA Elk Antler Auction. An announcement will be made and there will be a short pause for bidders to make their way to the auction block on Center Street before starting the bidding on the arch.

## ELK ANTLER ARCH AUCTION

Northwest Corner of  
THE JACKSON TOWN SQUARE

MAY 16<sup>th</sup>, 2015

1. The elk antler arch located on the northwest corner of the Jackson Town Square will be sold to the highest bidder. This sale will be immediately following the BSA Elk Antler Auction.
2. The arch is not being sold intact. The antlers will be disassembled and delivered to the buyer. The base and frame are not included.
3. There is no minimum bid.
4. Payment shall be by cash or check. Credit cards will not be accepted.
5. The antlers will be delivered to the winning bidder anywhere in Jackson Hole. Out of town buyers will have to accept delivery at the Town Square at the time the arch is disassembled.
6. The arch will be disassembled and delivered between May 18<sup>th</sup> and 27<sup>th</sup>.
7. Any variations to the above disassembly and delivery must have Town of Jackson approval and will be at buyer's expense.
